

Graphic Communications Solution (GCS) FXA Customer Training Course Outline

Objective

The objective of the GCS customer training course is to provide participants with a detailed understanding of your Fuji Xerox solution teaching you how to use the network production print server to efficiently manage your print jobs and achieve your expected print volume. The course is intended to augment basic learning, for the common controller components of Raster Image Processor (RIP) and the Fuji Xerox production engine training for the appropriate engine by providing practical hands-on training, troubleshooting of customer files, submitting documents to the GCS printer to produce high-quality output. These sessions will enable trained operators to commence production on their printing solution immediately upon install.

Training will be conducted on day one to suit each customer's individual needs. There is up to 0.5 day follow up skills assessment scheduled up to four weeks post training to complement the training content and to assist operators with any print related queries.

Pre-Requisites

- Ability to confidently navigate and perform standard Windows desktop and application functions without procedural instruction
- Familiarity with networked workstations and file directories
- If a participant cannot perform the above mentioned tasks a course in the appropriate operating systems for Windows is mandatory prior to attending. These course are available through external training institutes.
